
Freedom From the Penalty of Sin

1. You are justified by faith in Christ (Gal 3:13, 1:3-5, 2:14-16, 3:26, 4:4-7)


Freedom From the Power of Sin

- 1. Command 1: Stand Fast in Grace! (Gal 5:1, 13)
 - a. Recognize your position and the liberty you have in Christ (Gal 2:20)
- 2. Command 2: Walk in the Spirit! (Gal 5:16)
 - a. Present yourself to God and not to sin
 - b. The sin nature is rendered powerless verses the Holy Spirit

3. Consequences of choosing your Sin Nature




4. Consequences of Choosing the Holy Spirit



* Fruit of the Spirit

- Fruit is singular with nine "flavors". It is a complete package.
- H.S. produces the fruit in your life. All you do is chose to walk with Him. Fruit is manifested through you.
- Others benefit from your choice to walk with the Spirit
- If failing in one flavor, ask yourself, "Am I walking in sin or with the HS?"
