**B. The Exhortations We Need To Heed to Apply to our Christian lives (10:22-25)**

- The *issue* in Hebrews was the writer's concern of the constant \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ on the Hebrew believers coming from the Jewish community pressuring them to \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ as a way of life, instead of going on to \_\_\_\_\_ with the \_\_\_\_\_ they had embraced by \_\_\_\_\_!
- The *heart* of Hebrews is not a message of eternal salvation for sinners, but a significant \_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_ with serious \_\_\_\_\_ / \_\_\_\_\_ for believers to heed in order for them to enjoy the salvation they embraced by faith so as to go on to spiritual \_\_\_\_\_ and future \_\_\_\_\_. They were to “\_\_\_\_\_ the weight or sin which so easily ensnares them, and to look to \_\_\_\_\_ as the \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ of their faith” (Heb.12:1-2)
- The warning/exhortations have we noted so far:

Warning # 1 - Do not \_\_\_\_\_ mentally from the \_\_\_\_\_ & His so great salvation, through \_\_\_\_\_ of Him! (Hebrews 2:1)

Warning # 2 - Do not \_\_\_\_\_ through \_\_\_\_\_ in \_\_\_\_\_ from your focus & fellowship with the Lord in the \_\_\_\_\_ of life! (chp 3)

Warning # 3 - Do not fail to \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_ God has provided and \_\_\_\_\_ by His \_\_\_\_\_ through \_\_\_\_\_ for you! (chp 4)

Warning # 4 - Do not become \_\_\_\_\_ in your Christian walk, and avoid experiencing spiritual \_\_\_\_\_ in your Christian growth! (chp 5-6)

Warning # 6 - Do not sin \_\_\_\_\_ (in going back to Judaism) as there no longer remains any \_\_\_\_\_ for sins! (chp 10)

- What was set forth in Heb. 10:1-18?
- Why was this so serious?

\* What is the difference between “God’s \_\_\_\_\_” & “God’s \_\_\_\_\_!”

- 1) God’s *wrath* is reserved for those \_\_\_\_\_ the family of God – \_\_\_\_\_!
- 2) God’s *chastening* is for those wayward \_\_\_\_\_ who are part of the forever \_\_\_\_\_ of God who have lost their way, or are sinning \_\_\_\_\_!
- 3) God’s *wrath* involves \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_ who \_\_\_\_\_ God truth (Rom. 1); But God’s *love* in *chastening* involves \_\_\_\_\_ His wayward \_\_\_\_\_ to keep him on the straight & narrow way (Heb. 12)!

### C. The Application to Hebrews 10:26-31

1. Going back to Judaism & the temple sacrifices was a fatal \_\_\_\_\_ for these Hebrew believers, as this put them in the path of certain \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ indignation which was about to \_\_\_\_\_ the nation of Israel!
  - Why was Israel being judged by God?
2. The writer of Hebrews in 10:26-27, is noting that going back to Judaism & animal sacrifices at the temple would not avail anything but putting themselves in the \_\_\_\_\_ of certain coming judgment that was intended for the nation of \_\_\_\_\_ Israel! This judgment was \_\_\_\_\_ for the Hebrew believers, but for a generation of unbelieving \_\_\_\_\_ who had \_\_\_\_\_ their long waited Messiah!
  - Would God really do this to Israel? (10:28)
3. The writer now draws a *comparison* by saying how much worse \_\_\_\_\_ would one be thought worthy who has:
  - 1) \_\_\_\_\_ the Son of God \_\_\_\_\_ his foot
  - 2) counted the blood of the covenant by which he was \_\_\_\_\_ a \_\_\_\_\_ &
  - 3) \_\_\_\_\_ the Spirit of \_\_\_\_\_.

**The Point:** anyone who rejects \_\_\_\_\_ is certainly worthy of far more punishment than one who rejects \_\_\_\_\_!

**The point of the passage:** Those who identified with the nation under judgment would not \_\_\_\_\_ be the \_\_\_\_\_ of that judgment; but because they had gone back to Judaism & identified with the apostate nation, they would not \_\_\_\_\_ the severe, fiery, \_\_\_\_\_ coming on that nation!
