

## JESUS RETURNS TO GALILEE Luke 4:14-30

### I. Jesus Returns to Galilee

\*There were two main purposes for this:

- 1) To \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus as the \_\_\_\_\_ to the people whether Jew or Gentile.
- 2) To \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ the disciples who would follow Him & learn from Him, and eventually continue His ministry after His departure, to and through the \_\_\_\_\_.

#### A. His Reception in Galilee (Luke 4:14-15)

\*What was the *significance* of this reading?

As He concluded His reading, he \_\_\_\_\_ and did \_\_\_\_\_ include...

• Why did He stop where He did?
