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A. The **Sermon** on the Mount

The purpose of the Sermon was to <u>instruct</u> those who believed on Christ as Messiah and to <u>condemn</u> those who had not yet done so.							
Jesus raises the <u>level of righteousness</u> from a relative <u>human</u> standard to a <u>divine</u> standard							
Jesus shows that mankind <u>cannot</u> reach this level of righteousness							
For those who have accepted Jesus as the Messiah, it puts forth the righteous principles to be employed by faith as Jews until the kingdom is set up.							
The sermon also contains <u>trans-dispensational</u> <u>principles</u> which are to be applied by faith for the believer <u>today</u>							
Matthew 5:43-48 is the sixth of six units that begin "You have heard that it was said, but I say to you"
