“peace” (eirene) =

- There are two kinds of peace offered in scripture:

<sup>1</sup> *"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep."*
  - e. As the \_\_\_\_\_ **Shepherd**, Who \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ for His sheep (Hebrews 13:20-21)
  - f. As the \_\_\_\_\_ **Shepherd**, Who will one day \_\_\_\_\_ for His sheep to take them \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ them according to what they have done in life – **1 Peter 5:4**  
*and when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away.*
