**II. Paul's Acknowledgment & Appreciation of Their Gift (4:18)**

**A. Paul had \_\_\_\_\_ Their Gift (4:18a)**

\* Underscored by the use of 3 verbs in vs 18:

1. Because of you, "I \_\_\_\_\_"

2. And because of you, "I \_\_\_\_\_"

- How does this concept work practically? (Col 3:16)

3. And because of you, "I am \_\_\_\_\_"

- How did this gift come to Paul? (4:18)
