

## AS A CHRISTIAN, IS YOUR SALVATION FOREVER OR CAN IT BE LOST?

### DEFINING THE ISSUE FOR YOUR UNDERSTANDING

### SEARCHING THE SCRIPTURES FOR YOUR ETERNAL SECURITY

If you have trusted in Christ alone, your salvation is eternal and secure because ...

1. you are a CHILD OF GOD forever. (John 1:11-13)
2. eternal life lasts FOREVER (John 3:14-16)
3. if sin NO LONGER condemns the unbeliever, HOW COULD sin condemn you – the believer? (John 3:17-18)
4. the options are that either you HAVE eternal life or you have NEVER possessed it. (John 3:36)
5. if you could lose your salvation, you would spiritually THIRST and Christ promises that believers WILL NEVER THIRST (John 4:13-14)
6. Jesus Christ has promised that you SHALL NOT COME into condemnation (John 5:24)
7. Jesus Christ has promised NEVER to cast you out. (John 6:35-37)
8. it is God's will for you NEVER to be lost. (John 6:38-40)
9. Jesus Christ promises that you will NEVER PERISH FOREVER. (John 10:27-28)
10. Jesus Christ promises that NO ONE can pluck you out of Christ's hand in the present, nor out of the Father's hand in the future. (John 10:28-30)
11. it is IMPOSSIBLE for God to break His salvation promises to you. (Romans 5:8-10)
  
12. God has determined that you \_\_\_\_\_ in the future. (Romans 8:28-30)
  
13. God is for you, and Christ's death, resurrection, ascension, and intercession/advocacy for you secures that \_\_\_\_\_ can indict you in the \_\_\_\_\_ or condemn you in the \_\_\_\_\_. (Romans 8:31-34; Hebrews 7:25; 1 John 2:1-2; Revelation 12:9,10)
